Statement by the Leader of Nationalist Party Dr Adrian Delia

With reference to questions being put across by the media, I would like to declare in the most absolute and categorical manner that I have never met Yorgen Fenech after news emerged that he was involved in the company 17 Black.

I would also like to reaffirm all that I had stated to 'Lovin' Malta' on the 13th April 2019, and I am enclosing a copy of the replies that I had given 'Lovin' Malta' over a year and a month ago.



Statement to ‘Lovin’ Malta’ on the 13th April 2019

Have you ever had any business or professional relationship with Yorgen Fenech or any of his companies?

NO.

When was the last time you met Yorgen Fenech?

Certainly before 17 Black story came out.

Irrespectively however I must clarify that no amount of meetings, encounters, advertisements or whatever else one may consider as being an association of sorts , should ever be construed to indicate even remotely the possibility to dampen my fight against any kind of corruption.

I have , still am and always will fight against corruption. Of all sorts. It is in my nature. It is how I was brought up. It is who I am. It is what I believe.

I have sued the AG. The PM. The commissioner of lands. Vitals. I will persevere in seeking justice.

Nothing will stop me from doing so. No one will buy my silence. Not yesterday. Not today. Not ever.

This is not about words. This is not about perceptions. This is about a fight that we cannot give up on. A fight we cannot lose.
